**NOVICE** Dogs which have not been placed or Awarded a C.O.M. at a Field Trial or placed 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> in an Open Test or 1<sup>st</sup> in a Novice Test

**OPEN** Open to all Golden Retrievers

**DIRECTIONS:-** From the A57 Sheffield to Manchester main road, turn along Mortimer Road signposted for Strines Moor. This turning is between the Derbyshire boundary and Ladybower reservoir and has a sign for " Strines 13<sup>th</sup> century Inn" on the junction. Take the next left onto Sugworth Road. The venue will be signed in approx. 2 miles.

The tests will be held on heather moorland rushy ground moor edge in the Peak District National Park with a large pond and some steep gullies. There are no fences or high walls.
