* The Walk can be taken at anywhere of your choice with whoever you want to join you, **with any breed of dog**. This might be family or friends who are fellow dog walkers - who might also like to get themselves sponsored to help the MDD cause.

*** The Walk should be in the region of 5.76K (3.5 miles). A shorter walk of around 1K can be done for puppies, older dogs, and older handlers.**

*** Details of how sponsorship money, or donations, should be paid to the SGRS MDD Charity Account, by either cheque or Bank Transfer, are on the reverse side of the sponsorship form.**
